as she, Martha Lorimer, another village resident, and Gretchen Holm of Cornish walked by a 1947 Chevrolet truck.

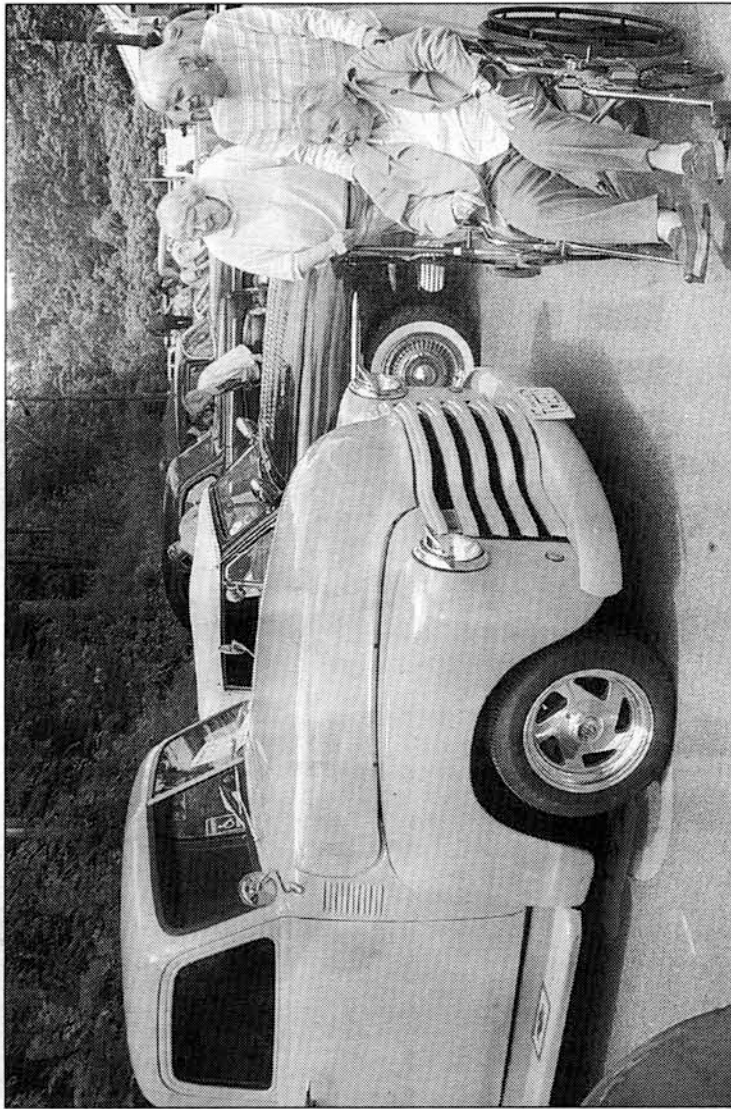
All three laughed when the word Studebaker was uttered, and good spirits were the theme of the day.
